Rose's Youth Philanthropists (RYP) is a regional youth grants committee that reviews and awards organizations that impact youth in a wide variety of fields in Chemung and Southeastern Steuben counties. The S. Roberts Rose Fund was established at the Community Foundation of the Elmira-Corning and the Finger Lakes Inc. in order to give youth a voice at the grantmaking table.

We are currently seeking new committee members for the 12-13 school year. Prospective members may want to know the following facts about RYP as they consider applying:

- RYP meets the first Sunday of each month at 12:00 p.m. (lunch is provided.)
- RYP consists of two representatives from seven area high schools, including Notre Dame, Southside, Elmira Free Academy, Edison, Horseheads, C-PP East, and C-PP West.
- Members evaluate a minimum of one non-profit agency (each year) in addition to the monthly meetings to evaluate a grant from the previous year.
- RYP develops and distributes a Request for Proposals each February and accepts grant applications until the end of March.
- RYP grants \$8,000 per year to local youth-serving organizations.
