

American Association of University Women Scholarship

The American Association of University Women (AAUW) Scholarship is awarded to a woman who has demonstrated a commitment to excellence in the areas of scholastic ability, character, and extracurricular/community involvement. Degree of financial need will also be considered. This is a \$500 award.

Only candidates from one of the following groups are eligible:

- Female seniors from high schools in the Corning-Painted Post, Addison, and Campbell-Savona school districts who plan to begin their freshman year at a four-year college or university full-time.
- Sophomore women seeking degrees at Corning Community College who are planning to enter their junior year at a four-year college or university full-time.
- Adult women whose education has been interrupted for various reasons and who are attempting to complete a four-year degree by entering or re-entering a four-year college or university full-time.

Application Requirements

Please return the following to the Foundation's office by **February 16, 2012**.

- A completed application form
It is important that you answer ALL the appropriate questions.
Either complete section V or enclose a copy of your parent/guardian's most recent tax return
- A typed purpose statement
- Three statements of reference
References must include one teacher and two persons not related to the applicant. Please provide each reference with a copy of the Reference Form and a self-addressed stamped envelope in order for him/her to return the reference directly to the Community Foundation.
- A transcript that includes GPA, SAT scores, and class rank

Please return all requested information to ensure a complete process of the application.
